GENIUM Consolidated Feed® MIGRATION PROJECT

Release weekend

On February 2nd GENIUM Consolidated Feed will replace TARGIN as market data system for NASDAQ OMX Nordic markets. The upgrade of the production system will be performed in the weekend before Monday morning launch and the possibility to test connections to the production system will be offered from Sunday February 1st 08.00 CET. The production system will be unavailable during the upgrade on Saturday January 31st.

The connectivity settings for the GENIUM Consolidated Feed are the same as for the current TARGIN production system. This means that the same IP and port number as well as user name and password from current TARGIN production system will be used.

A full basic data load is mandatory related to the upgrade to GENIUM Consolidated Feed.

Reminder: Extension of trading hours in Baltic exchanges as of February 2nd, 2009

We would like to remind you that starting from February 2, 2009, trading period for all sub-markets of the NASDAQ OMX Baltic stock exchanges in Riga, Tallinn and Vilnius will be prolonged by 2 hours, remaining open until 4:00 pm (EET). On the stock exchanges in Tallinn, Riga and Vilnius continuous trading will start at its current time of 9:59 am (EET) and trading will end at 4:00 pm (EET). Currently, continuous trading ends at 2:00 pm (EET). Please find information on the structure and time schedules of the trading day for all Baltic submarkets in the enclosed appendixes.

The initiative is set to generate higher trading activity in the Baltic market and to attract more foreign investors. After extending the trading hours investors will be able to trade longer and the trading hours will better correspond to the working hours of other markets in Europe. The extended trading period will also provide Baltic investors with more time to follow the global trends and react on them timely.

First North Premier launch on February 16th, 2009

The new market segment allows companies to enhance their visibility, thereby enabling increased liquidity in their shares. The segment is also targeted towards companies that are seeking a listing on the main Nordic market, NASDAQ OMX Nordic. First North Premier will be introduced on February 16, 2009.
