Exchange Notice**Derivatives – Product Information 1/12****Standardized combination order book to facilitate the transition from OMX Copenhagen 20 to OMX Copenhagen 20 Cap**

As of January 9, 2012, NASDAQ OMX will list a standardized combination order book to facilitate the transition from OMXC20 futures to OMXC20CAP futures.

The combination order book will consist of the OMXC20 January future and the OMXC20CAP February future. It will function in the same way as the current combination order book for OMXC20. That is, if you buy 1 contract in the combination you will be buying 1 contract of the OMXC20CAP February future and selling 1 contract of the OMXC20 January future. If you sell the combination you will be selling the OMXC20CAP February future and buying the OMXC20 January future. The series designation for this combination order book will be C20TOCAP2BTS. The last trading day will be January 20, 2012.

Note that since the two indices are different with different index values, the value of your exposure will change if you trade 1 OMXC20 contract for 1 OMXC20CAP contract.

As of January 23, 2012, NASDAQ OMX will begin listing standardized combination order books for OMXC20CAP futures. The available combinations will from January 23, 2012 be February/March and March/April. The series designation for the February/March combination will be C20CAP2CTS.
